RESTORATION OF WOODROW WILSON FAMILY HOME

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

Interested architects or architectural firms are invited to submit qualifications to be considered for the restoration of the Wood-

row Wilson Family Home. Qualifications will be received by Robin Waites, Executive Director, Historic Columbia Foundation, 1601 Richland Street, Columbia, SC 29201, until 4:00pm, July 7, 2006. Questions should be directed to Ms. Waites at (803) 252-7742.

The Historic Columbia Foundation serves as the steward of the Woodrow Wilson Family Home located at 1701 Hampton Street, Columbia, SC. The Andrew Jackson Downing-inspired residence was erected circa 1871-72 under the guidance of architect Gustavus Theodore Berg. The Wilson family lived at the address from 1872-74. Following their departure it continued as a single-family residence until the late 1920s. It opened as a shrine to the 28th president in 1932. Since 1966 Historic Columbia Foundation has operated the site as an historic house museum.

Historic Columbia Foundation, in partnership with Richland County, wishes to return the site to its 1872 form & continue to operate it as an historic house museum.

Historic Columbia Foundation seeks the services of an architect or architectural firm specializing in historic preservation to provide plans & specifications for the restoration of the building to its original form & well as plans & specifications for the reconstruction of two support structures, which were are no longer extant. In addition the qualified applicant will serve as project director for overseeing the complete restoration of the exterior & interior of the property.

The following services will be requested from the selected architect or firm:

1. Conduct a physical investigation of the building to determine form of original structure.
2. Provide plans & specifications for restoration of existing historic components & new construction of missing historically important aspects.
3. Work with Executive Director of Historic Columbia Foundation to oversee restoration & new construction of all buildings on site.

Interested firms shall provide the following information:

3. A brief description of the firm including number of years of experience the firm has with projects related to historic preservation

**FLOW MONITORING PROGRAM
FOR WESTERN CAROLINA REGIONAL
SEWER AUTHORITY**

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority (WCRSA) will receive proposals from firms interested in providing ongoing services to monitor wastewater flows within the WCRSA service area & quantify infiltration & inflow (I/I) in the sewer basins until 1:30 pm, on June 29, 2006, at the Purchasing Department, 670 Mauldin Road, Greenville, SC 29607. Proposals may also be personally carried to the opening at 2:00pm, at the Administration Building located at 561 Mauldin Road, Greenville, SC 29607, where they will be publicly opened. Please enclose eight (8) copies of the proposal.

Currently WCRSA maintains 52 permanent flow meters & 13 temporary flow meters. The permanent meters provide long-term flow data & track system performance under different groundwater conditions & rainfall events. The permanent flow monitors will also provide valuable information on increases in I/I due to deteriorating sewers or changes within the system (such as growth & development). Temporary meters are used extensively by WCRSA. They are installed up to 60 days & then are moved to another location. WCRSA also maintains 13 rain gauges throughout the system.

WCRSA desires to increase the program to 93 permanent meters & 25 temporary meters for a total of 118 meters & utilize outside resources. A map showing the current & proposed flow meter locations is available upon request. The collection system subdistricts or municipalities may require metering assistance under this contract. The scope of services will include:

- Operation & maintenance of all 118 meters including necessary maintenance, scrubbing of sensors, battery replacement, repairs, spare parts (i.e. sensors, bands, etc.) & site visits necessary to insure proper operation of

all meters at all times. The additional meters will be purchased by WCRSA. All meters installed within the system, including the temporary meters, will require calibration on a monthly basis.

- Currently 52 permanent meters are installed. The firm will install the additional 41 permanent meters & perform mini-basin studies utilizing the 25 temporary meters as needed. The permanent meters are Sigma 920 & the temporary meters are Sigma 910.
- Monthly collection, review, analysis, & reporting of meter & rain gauge data are required, including, but not limited to, dry weather flow, maximum hourly flows, Babbitt Allowable Peaking Factor, maximum level during wet weather event, & capacity based on dry weather & wet weather. These data & reports will be customized to WCRSA's needs & must be certified by a South Carolina Professional Engineer.
- Proposals must include & will be evaluated in order of importance based on the following information:
- Proposed project manager including his/her experience & availability for the flow monitoring program.
- Specific timeframe & experience of the firm on other flow monitoring projects.
- References.
- Specific personnel committed to the program, including their experience & availability.

The proposal should be no more than fifteen (15) pages in length with no pamphlets or literature attached. A breakdown of the costs associated with the flow monitoring program is required. WCRSA will review the submitted proposals & select a firm for the project. Interviews may be requested of a few selected firms as part of the selection process. The contract will be a three-year contract to be renewed annually up to five years allowing up to a 5% increase each year.
