The University Proposes To Construct
two 30,000 square feet additions that will
flank the north entrance to Thomas Cooper
Library on the Columbia campus. One addi-
tion will house USC's Modern Political Col-
lections & the other will house USC's Rare
Book Collection. Construction of this build-
ing is unique in that the majority of the
square footage will be below grade & will
require a contractor with experience in spe-
cialty shoring & excavation techniques,

deep grade waterproofing, installation of unique mechanical systems & working with existing congested underground utilities. Severe site restraints will require that the below grade foundation waterproofing system be placed against the sheeting & shoring system in a "blind-side" condition. This same type of waterproofing system will be placed below the three foot thick foundation mat. Construction of the new foundations will be critical in that the basement walls of the new buildings will not only support loads from the new building & the surrounding earth pressures, but will also support lateral earth pressure from the existing building foundations due to displaced soil from the new building excavations. For this work, we will require a specialty contractor with numerous years of experience in design / construction of deep excavation & shoring systems adjacent to existing buildings. The building mechanical system is also a critical feature of this unique building in that the temperature & especially humidity control are crucial to the preservation of the important building contents that will be stored below grade.
