The South Carolina Department Of Transportation (SCDOT) requests letters of interest & proposals from all interested parties experienced in all phases of highway design & construction to provide roadway & bridge design & construction services for improvements to fourteen (14) miles of US Route 17 from just south of S-15-162 (Wiggins Road) to just north of SC Route 64 in Jacksonboro in Colleton County, SC. The anticipated improvements include widening existing US Route 17 & replacing three bridges (Ashepoa River, CSX Railroad, & Tupelo Swamp). SCDOT & the Federal Highway Administration will be using the design-build method of contracting for this federal-aid project.

A proposer will be deemed non-responsive if the evaluation of their technical proposal results in a score of less than 85. In these cases, a proposer's cost envelope will be returned unopened.

The South Carolina Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is seeking qualified vendors capable of supplying several species of accelerated growth oak tree saplings meeting the specifications listed below.

Saplings, at a minimum of 2 feet tall, shall conform to the following specifications. Vendor supplying plant material must be able to provide written documentation that trees conform to the following characteristics & growing methodology.

- Container grown trees shall be produced by a multi-staged, air root-pruned production method that develops a dense, fibrous, root system with a dry weight of 90g or greater per tree.
- Final transplanting shall be into 2 gallon containers.
- The container root structure shall be rooted sufficiently to hold growing media in place if removed from container.
- Documentation shall be provided by the tree supplier indicating that trees grown via their process, preferably the Root Production Method®, demonstrate flower & seed production by year 7 for species which typically do not produce flower & seed for 15 to 20 years.
- Seed source must be within the bio-regions appropriate to the planting site (Georgetown County, SC).
- Product is preferably grown within 200 miles of project site or in Heat Zone* 8 as outlined in: <http://www.ahs.org/pdfs/heatmap.pdf>

*Heat zones refer to the ability of a plant to survive drought & heat stress that is more common as our planet experiences the effects of climate change. For information on Heat Zones (not to be confused with the USDA Hardiness zone), please go to the American Horticultural Society at: http://www.ahs.org/publications/heat_zone_map.htm

- 200 EA Quercus lyrata (Overcup Oak)
- 200 EA Quercus texana (Nuttal Oak)
- 70 EA Quercus bicolor (Swamp White Oak)
- 70 EA Quercus michauxii (Swamp Chestnut Oak)
- 70 EA Quercus phellos (Willow Oak)
- 33 EA Quercus shumardii (Shumard's Oak)
