**WEST LEXINGTON
 WATERLINE UPGRADES**

The Town Of Lexington's Capital Improvement Plan Includes the need to upgrade waterlines in parts of West Lexington. This RFP focuses on the upgrade of waterlines on Allen, George & Clark Streets that currently feed water to homes through a 2 inch line. The upgrade will impact 27 homes on these streets & upgrade the existing 2 inch line to a 6 inch waterline. The original water service was installed decades ago & is functioning but does not support enough flow for proper fire protection & restricts the overall available pressure to

the residents on those streets. The upgrade will provide better water flow to the homes, enable the installation of fire hydrants on those streets & bolster the entire water grid in the West Lexington area. All work is expected to be performed within public right-of-ways.

The Town Of Lexington Is Soliciting Proposals from qualified firms to provide engineering services for the project. Services will include, but may not be limited to, preparation of plans & specifications, submission of plans to all regulatory agencies for permits, bidding process, contract administration, construction inspection & oversight, & verification of contractor billings.

REQUEST FOR PREQUALIFICATIONS

Project: CITY OF CHARLESTON – SEAWALL REPAIRS: REPAIR and/or RECONSTRUCTION OF A PORTION OF THE HIGH BATTERY

Location: Along East Battery & Murray Boulevard-peninsula area of Charleston, SC

Purpose: The City of Charleston is pre-qualifying contractors for the first phase of a seawall repair & rehabilitation project. Overall, the seawalls, known as The High Battery & The Low Battery, were examined & their conditions documented in a report prepared by Cummings & McCrady, Inc. in 2004. This report, entitled "Seawall Evaluation & Study", also included suggested repairs & a phasing schedule for the proposed work. The City has proceeded with development of design documents & has applied for permits to initiate the repair work of the "Turn" of the High Battery (described below). At this time, the City of Charleston wishes to prequalify contractors for work on this first phase of the proposed repair/rehabilitation projects.

Description Of Seawalls: The Low Battery was constructed as part of a large land reclamation project undertaken in two phases (1909-1911 & 1917-1919). The concrete wall of the Low Battery was constructed on a timber deck supported by timber pilings. The seaward face of the Low Battery is skirted with concrete panels attached to timber sheeting & batter piles. This system formed a retaining wall system to retain the landside fill.

The High Battery consists of two (2) distinct designs: The original High Battery (reconstructed in 1893-1894) is comprised of a stone wall (seaward) backed by two (2) masonry/concrete walls approximately 10 feet apart.

The space between the two walls is backfilled with soil & the top is capped with stone slabs to create a walkway or promenade.

The second part of the High Battery, "The Turn" was constructed in 1919. This portion of the Battery connected the High Battery to the Low Battery, creating a continuous seawall from north of Water Street to just south of Tradd Street. Construction of the "Turn" used methods very similar to those used in the construction of the Low Battery. The repair of the "Turn" is the first phase of the overall seawall repair project.

Due to the complex nature & historic significance of the walls, specific construction expertise is required for this project. Only those contractors with significant experience & expertise will be allowed to bid on the project. Potential bidders should also have considerable experience working with historic structures in the marine environment & on urban streets with limited access as well as meeting the minimum requirements listed below. The project is anticipated to be released for bid beginning in the spring/summer of this year. Project duration is expected to be nine months.

Standards for prequalification of contractors:

The City of Charleston intends to prequalify all contractors wishing to bid on the said seawall project. All contractors must have the scheduling expertise for scheduling all aspects of the project from start to finish. Any contractor with a history of excessive change orders will not be considered for the project. The following shall be the minimum requirements established for prequalification:

- Provide a corporate resume' listing projects in which the Contractor acted as the prime or subcontractor directly responsible for the reconstruction and/or repair work on projects with similar size & character.
- Furnish proof in the form of a resume' that the proposed project superintendent has at least five (5) years' experience in seawall repair work on projects of similar size & character along with five (5) references of those responsible for supervision of these projects. Include names, addresses, & telephone numbers of references that will testify to the successful completion of these projects by the superintendent. The resume' should also include the names of companies the individual was employed by while conducting the work.

Description of the work: Generally, the work of this project consists of seawall repair & rehabilitation of the "Turn" of the High Battery in peninsula Charleston. General elements of work include:

- Installing cofferdams & or other sheeting/shoring as required
- Dewatering the subject work area(s).
- Cleaning & removal of deteriorated sections of the seawalls.
- Installation & testing of piling.
- Construction of the concrete portions of the seawalls

- Resetting & leveling adjacent stone walls & walking surfaces
- Pointing & grouting adjacent stone walls & walking surfaces
- Asphalt resurfacing & repair as required.
- All associated project scheduling, traffic control & public information management
