Superfluous Taxes & Fees on Fuel Invoices

It's come to our attention that at least one of the vendors on the ULSD/B10 Biofuel contracts has been charging taxes and fees as *separate line items* on their invoices. Those fees are ALREADY built into the daily fuel prices on our <u>website</u>.

Reminder: all required taxes and fees are calculated into the Daily Fuel Prices at <u>https://procurement.sc.gov/contracts/fuel</u>. Your organization should not be paying ANY separately itemized additional fees or taxes listed on an invoice. Within those fuel contracts for which we've issued a change order permitting a cost-plus scenario, taxes and fees are also included in the "cost" portion of that. You shouldn't see any itemized taxes and fees on the invoice unless all price components are itemized.



We **STRONGLY** recommend you review your fuel invoices from (at minimum) the past year to ensure you weren't over charged. If you were, get with the contactor ASAP, even if the contract has expired and/or the vendor is no longer on contract. Those taxes and fees could potentially be refunded. If you have specific questions, please reach out to the procurement manager on that contract for assistance. Our expectation is that each contractor will work with you to resolve discrepancies.

ADA Bus Contracts

We've learned some of the ADA Bus contractors state they can't hold their contracted pricing, even for orders placed a year ago or more, on the previous contract that's already expired. The contractors should be reaching out to you individually, if you have a PO in place, to tell you what your options are. Drug & Alcohol, Background Screening (June Update)

Premier Biotech, the primary Contractor for drug & alcohol testing and background screenings, is continuing to finalize the transition of their invoicing processes. SFAA DPS received only a couple of calls concerning the process so things appear to be proceeding well. We did get one call from someone processing invoices who doesn't get *DisPatcheS*. They weren't aware of the transition. Please share this information with anyone processing invoices so they'll know some will come from SallyPort and some from Premier Biotech until the transition is complete. Supply Chain Disruptions Continue

It should come as no surprise that worldwide supply chain disruptions continue to wreak havoc on our statewide term contracts. We're working with every contractor who contacts us to make sure that we keep our agreements in place, so you don't have to go without. Each contract is different and we sometimes have to be creative in our solutions. The best source of information is going to be this newsletter and the <u>contract sheet associated with the contract on our website</u>. Check those often for the contracts you're working with for important updates.





<u>Career Ready Assessments (TBD)</u> – Michael Speakmon (<u>mspeakmon@mmo.sc.gov</u>) is continuing to work with DEW and SCDE to modify the scope before republishing the next solicitation.

NASPO Small Package Delivery Services (June Update)

Our office received an email response from UPS on June 23rd concerning a Participating Addendum (PA) between UPS and South Carolina. They're still reviewing our documents to determine if they're willing to comply with the State's terms and conditions. As of this writing, UPS still only has a total of eight (8) PAs published on the NASPO website.

At this point, the contract with FedEx is the only one active and available for use. It's a requirement for all governmental bodies, as defined by 11-35-310(18), to use established statewide term contracts when they exist. Failure to use an established statewide term contract may have a negative impact on the governmental body's procurement activities. Our office will be working with FedEx in the com-

<u>Grounds Equipment (Phase I & II) (Expires 5/31/2023)</u> – Ellicia Howard (<u>ehoward@mmo.sc.gov</u>) (Phase I) and Portia Davis (<u>pdavis@mmosc.gov</u>) (Phase II) are just beginning their research into these contracts. Typically these contracts manage themselves, but we'll still want to know if you've experienced any unexplained issues during the contract term. Are there brands of equipment you'd like to see that aren't listed? Is there a category of equipment you think would be a good addition? <u>Motors – Marine Inboard/Outboard (Expires 6/18/2023)</u> – This is the companion contract to the STC for Boats.
