New Stono Park Elementary School

The work includes, but is not limited to, the construction of a new, two-story, fully sprinkled, 75,000 square foot elementary school, located on Myers Road, on the same site as the previous building. The facility will be constructed predominately of structural concrete masonry and steel with brick veneer, metal joists, and decking. A single roof system will be utilized overall (modified bituminous sheet system). A direct air to air HVAC system is used for the majority of the spaces with a separate make-up air system providing outside air.
